The first step...



Little Grange Nursery provides a modern environment offering activities aimed at developing interpersonal skills and to enable the children to gain independence and confidence at their own pace. The learning experience aims to inspire the child inside and outside of the classroom and follows the Early Years Foundation Stage 1 six areas of learning.

Children receive specialist teaching in ICT, Music, Gymnastics and Dance and have full access to the School’s facilities. A variety of options, including morning, afternoon, all day and extended care are available.

Starting school...

The Pre Preparatory Department incorporates Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. Children start in Reception at the start of the September term. Learning continues to follow the Early Years Foundation curriculum and builds upon the secure foundations laid in Little Grange.

The Reception classes share a new building complete with outdoor learning and play environment. Activities in each area are mirrored which enables learning to flow seamlessly from indoors to outdoors.

Each class has it’s own area and benefits from an open plan layout so the children can have access to all resources throughout the day. Both Reception teachers are supported by a teaching assistant enabling the children to work in small groups and on a one to one basis.



Gaining independence...

In Years 1 and 2 emphasis is placed on literacy and numeracy which is supported by a broad range of activities and subjects throughout the curriculum. In addition to the core subjects of English, Maths, Science and ICT, children are taught History, Geography, Art Design and Technology, P.E and Religious Studies.

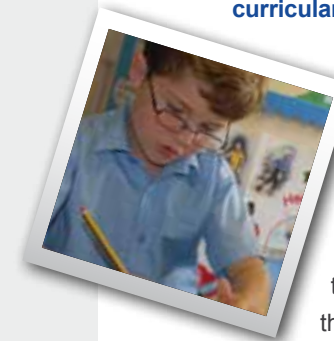
